

RESOLUTION NO. 36 - 2001

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP SERVICES DIRECTOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, West Chester Township in Butler County, Ohio is planning to make capital improvements to repair and/or replace culverts and roads damaged by heavy rains and flooding on July 17 and 18, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements herein above described are considered to be a priority need for the community and are qualified projects under the OPWC programs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the West Chester Township Board of Trustees do hereby agree that:

Section 1. The Services Director is hereby authorized to apply to the Ohio Public Works Commission for funds as described above.

Section 2. The Township Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3. This Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and welfare of the citizens of West Chester Township and shall become effective upon passage.

This resolution shall be adopted as an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare of the community.
