RESOLUTION 3, 1988

BUTLER COUNTY, OHIO

Be it resolved by the Township Trustees of Union Township, that

WHEREAS, Union Township residents adopted the Butler County Zoning Resolution in November 1956, and have operated continuously since that time under that resolution and its revisions, which have been administered by Butler County, and

WHEREAS, Union Township has experienced unprecedented growth far exceeding the development of other unincorporated areas of Butler County, and

WHEREAS, even with direct citizen representation of Union Township on boards and commissions at the county level involved with planning and zoning, the ultimate control nevertheless rests outside Union Township, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the best interests of the citizens of Union Township would be served through the adoption of township zoning,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Union Township declares its intention to proceed with establishing township zoning under Sections 519.02 through 519.25, inclusive, of the Ohio Revised Code.
