

RESOLUTION No. 16-88-1

Butler County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Union Township,

that the functions of the Union Township Park Board will be as follows:

SECTION 1. Members. There is hereby created and established a Park Committee of Union Township which shall consist of seven (7) members. All of whom shall be voting members.

One of the Trustees shall be a Liaison as established at the Union Township Trustee Organization meeting, or as soon thereafter as possible. This person shall serve until the next organizational meeting of the Board of Trustees or until he ceases to be a member of the Board of Trustees.

The seven (7) members shall be residents of the township and shall be appointed by the Board of trustees.

Effective June 1, 1984, two (2) members are appointed for one (1) year, two (2) for two (2) years and two (2) for three (3) years. The Park Director will be the seventh (7th) member of the park committee and will serve as a non-voting chairman of the park committee.

SECTION 2. Officers and Meetings. The Park Committee shall organize on the first Thursday in June of each year by electing a Chairperson and a Vice-Chairperson and Secretary to serve for a one (1) year period. The Trustee Liaison shall not hold an office. The committee shall hold regular meetings at least once every month, which shall be a regularly established time and open to the public. The committee shall establish rules and regulations for its government and performance of duties. The Secretary shall keep full and complete minutes of all of the committee's proceedings and said minutes shall be a public record and copies kept on file with the Park Director.

SECTION 3. Powers. Following the appropriation by the Board of Trustees of money for the parks, the Park Board has the right to suggest the improvements in the park as well as equipment needed. The Park Board will have the authority to schedule all events in the park and it shall have the power to maintain such privately owned lands or buildings whose use for public recreational purposes may be temporarily granted by the owners, subject to approval first by the Board of Trustees.

At no time, however, shall the Committee schedule more than 50% at Keehner Park or 75% at McGinnis Park or any of the above mentioned facilities without the express consent of a majority of the Board of Trustees.
