

RESOLUTION No. 21-86

Butler County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Union Township,

that there is hereby adopted by the Union Township Trustees the fire control measures and regulations as herein set forth for the purposes of controlling conditions which could impede or interfere with fire suppressions forces.

SECTION I, Building within 450 feet of a fire hydrant

- A] Hydrant locations
No building shall be approved for construction unless the proposed building is within 450 feet of an approved fire hydrant. Every part of any such building shall be within 450 feet of a fire hydrant located on public or private property accessible to vehicular fire equipment unless the fire official determines that such requirement would create an undue hardship. This distance is measured using hard surfaced roadway capable of supporting 40 tons and not less than 15 feet in unobstructed width.
- B] Such fire hydrants shall be capable of supplying fire flows as required by the fire official and shall be connected to a water system in accordance with accepted engineering practices.
- C] The fire official shall designate and approve the number and locations of fire hydrants.
- D] Private hydrants shall not be placed into or removed from service until approved by the fire official and will be subject to annual inspection by the local fire official.

SECTION II, Penalties

- A] Whoever violates Section 505.374 of the Ohio Revised Code is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. Each day of continued violations is a separate offense.
- B] Penalties as established by Butler County Court, Ohio, shall prevail.

SECTION III, Validity

The Board of Trustees of Union Township, Butler County, Ohio, hereby declare that should any section, paragraph, sentence, or word of this resolution for any reason be found to be invalid, it is the intent of the Board of Trustees of Union Township, Butler County, Ohio, that it would have passed all other portions of this resolution independent of the elimination here from of any such portion as may be declared invalid.

SECTION IV, Date of Effect

This resolution shall become effective and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.
