There were no citizen's comments.

Presentations

West Chester Township Fire Chief Rick Prinz gave a presentation on the local response to the COVID-19 virus, and responded to questions from the Board.

MOTION made by Mr. Wong, seconded by Mr. Welch, to approve the Trustee Meeting Minutes for March 10, 2020. Discussion: none. **Motion carried unanimously.**

MOTION made by Mr. Welch, seconded by Mr. Wong, to approve payment of bills.

Mr. Wong had made a point of order that he recently stepped down from the "Board Chair" position at the Chinese Chamber of Commerce and he would be recusing himself from voting on item #2.

MOTION made by Mr. Welch, seconded by Mrs. Becker, to approve payment of requisition 2. Discussion: In response to Mr. Welch's question, Mr. Burks said the purchase of masks from the Midwest Chinese Chamber of Commerce was in conjunction with UC Health. Mr. Wong said the purchase order from West Chester Hospital/UC Health was \$150,000. Chief Prinz responded to questions from the Board. Mr. Wong had indicated he would be recusing himself on item 2. Motion carried. Mr. Wong recused himself.

MOTION made by Mr. Welch, seconded by Mr. Wong, to approve payment of requisition 1, and 3 through 7. Discussion: none. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Personnel Items

Mr. Burks introduced the next item by stating the township's history of merit raises, and noting this item only establishes the pool, though no increase would be given until mid-July. He also expressed the need to retain qualified, experienced employees.

MOTION made by Mr. Wong, seconded by Mr. Welch, to Motion to approve 3.5% merit pool for the 2020 merit performance increases; and, a not to exceed 4% individual increase for qualified non-contract exempt and non-exempt employees; and authorize the Township Administrator to approve and apply said merit performance increases effective the first full pay period of July 2020 subject to approved and related policies and procedures. Discussion: Mr. Wong emphasized that the item does not entail pay raises and that the Trustees have the power to pull any raises before July. He also said this applies only to non-contract employees. Mrs. Becker also emphasized that any raises would be based on merit. Mr. Welch noted that the township has had a problem previously in extending merit raises late in the year, requiring retroactive increases. Motion carried unanimously.

Business Items

MOTION made by Mr. Welch, seconded by Mr. Wong, to not object to a C1 and C2 liquor permit transfer from UDF Limited Partnership I dba United Dairy Farmers 094, 9594 Cincinnati Columbus Road, to AD Shah LLC dba TJ Sunoco, 9594 Cincinnati Columbus Road. Discussion: none. **Motion carried unanimously.**

First Reading of Resolutions & Reading of Emergency Resolutions

Rather, concerned citizens should contact either their Congressperson or the FCC.

Patrick Barnett, 7986 Tylers Way, asked Mr. Welch how his military service would affect his response to the COVID-19 crisis, and thanked Mr. Welch for his service.

Dead birds, dead bees, dead babies. My name is Michael DiSalvo. As someone with a painful autoimmune condition of 25 years I was naturally interested in the outcome of the Obamacare healthcare takeover in 2010, but not in a way some people would think.
