RESOLUTION NO. 36-2020

Resolution finding the 2002 Ford F550 Bucket Truck is not needed or unfit for public use; authorizing the sale of said equipment at public auction

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly amended Ohio Revised Code, Section 505.10 (1) and enacted procedures for Townships to dispose of property including motor vehicles, road machinery, equipment and tools which are not needed, obsolete, or are unfit for public use; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined the 2002 Ford F550 Bucket Truck is not needed, obsolete, or unfit for public use and for the use for which they were purchased; and,

WHEREAS, when the value of said items, in the opinion of the Board of Township Trustees, is in excess of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00), the Board may sell the property by public auction to the highest bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the West Chester Township Board of Trustees does hereby agree to:

SECTION 1. Determine said vehicle in the opinion of the Board of Trustees has a value in excess of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00).

SECTION 2. Find said vehicle is not needed, obsolete, and is unfit for public use and for the use it was acquired.

SECTION 3. Declare said vehicle as surplus and offer for public auction, GovDeals or Cincinnati Auto Auction.
