

RESOLUTION NO. 16-2022

Resolution finding multiple police department vehicles are not needed or are unfit for public use; authorizing the disposal of said vehicles through sale to Great Oaks Career Campuses; and, crediting the sale price as tuition for the police academy

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly amended Ohio Revised Code, Section 505.101 and enacted procedures for Townships to dispose of property including motor vehicles, road machinery, equipment and tools which are not needed, obsolete, or are unfit for public use; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined the vehicles listed in the table below are not needed, obsolete, or unfit for public use and for the use for which they were purchased; and


WHEREAS, the Township Trustees wish to enter into a contract to sell said vehicles to a department or agency or political subdivision of the state; and,

SECTION 1. Find said vehicles are not needed, obsolete, and are unfit for public use and for the use it was acquired.






