

RESOLUTION NO. 07-2023

Statutory Resolution declaring a 1997 Emergency Quint Fire apparatus is not needed and unfit for public use and authorizing sale of said apparatus by public auction

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly amended Ohio Revised Code, Section 505.10 and enacted procedures for Townships to dispose of motor vehicles, road machinery, equipment, and tools which are not needed, obsolete, or are unfit for public use; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that one 1997 Emergency Quint, designated as Engine 797 by the West Chester Fire Department, purchased in 1997, taken out of front-line service in 2018 and placed into reserve status, is not needed or is unfit for public use and for the use for which it was purchased; and,

WHEREAS, the value of the 1997 Emergency Quint is in excess of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) as determined by a comparison of like make and model fire apparatus currently for sale.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the West Chester Township Board of Trustees does hereby agree to:

SECTION 1. Determine said vehicle in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, has a value in excess of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00).

SECTION 2. Find said vehicle is not needed, obsolete, and is unfit for public use and for the use it was acquired.

SECTION 3. Authorize the Township Administrator to execute any and all documents required to effectuate the sale.

SECTION 4. Declare said vehicle as surplus and offer for public auction, GOV Deals or Cincinnati Auto Auction.


