

STATUTORY RESOLUTION NO. 11 - 2012

RESOLUTION FINDING 2001 JOHN DEERE 4X2 UTILITY VEHICLE IS NOT NEEDED OR IS UNFIT FOR PUBLIC USE, AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SAID EQUIPMENT TO BOBCAT ENTERPRISES, INC. AND CREDITING THE SALE PRICE OF SAID EQUIPMENT TO THE PURCHASE OF A BOBCAT UTILITY 4X4 VEHICLE FROM BOBCAT ENTERPRISES, INC.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §505.10(3) West Chester Township (“Township”) may sell equipment not needed or unfit for public use and have the sale price credited to the purchase of other equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the Township finds a 2001 John Deere 4x2 utility vehicle (“Equipment”) is not needed or is unfit for public use; and,

WHEREAS, Community Services maintenance operations require the use of a utility vehicle, to serve the needs of the public; and,

WHEREAS, Bobcat Enterprises, Inc. has offered a trade-in value of \$2,500.00 toward the purchase of a new 4x4 utility vehicle.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the West Chester Township Board of Trustees does hereby agree to:

SECTION 1. Sell the not needed or unfit Equipment to Bobcat Enterprises, Inc., credit the \$2,500.00 trade-in price of the Equipment toward the purchase of a Bobcat 4x4 utility vehicle in the total amount of \$5,584.80 from Bobcat Enterprises, Inc.




