

STATUTORY RESOLUTION NO. 20 - 2012

RESOLUTION FINDING ONE (1) RADAR UNIT IS NOT NEEDED OR IS UNFIT FOR PUBLIC USE, AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SAID EQUIPMENT TO PB ELECTRONICS AND CREDITING THE SALE PRICE OF SAID EQUIPMENT TO THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) RADAR UNIT, CERTIFICATION, AND ONE (1) YEAR WARRANTY FROM PB ELECTRONICS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §505.10(3) West Chester Township (“Township”) may sell equipment not needed or unfit for public use and have the sale price credited to the purchase of other equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the Township finds one (1) Radar Unit (“Equipment”), is not needed or is unfit for public use; and,

WHEREAS, Equipment is critical to the Police Department’s service of increasing awareness of and for traffic safety and obligations of enforcing the traffic laws of the State of Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, PB Electronics has offered a trade-in value of \$100.00 toward the purchase of new equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the West Chester Township Board of Trustees does hereby agree to:

SECTION 1. Sell the not needed or unfit Equipment to PB Electronics, credit the \$100.00 sale price of the Equipment toward the purchase of one (1) Radar Unit, certification, and one (1) year warranty in the total amount of \$1,910.00 from PB Electronics.


