RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE LEVY OF A REPLACEMENT TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION

WHEREAS, the electors of the Township approved a continuing levy of 4.5 mills and a continuing levy of 2.5 mills during the May and November elections of 2001, respectively (collectively, hereinafter the "Original Levies"), each such Original Levy for the Township's benefit;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.19(J) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Original Levies were enacted for the purpose of the payment of salaries of permanent police personnel, including the payment of the police officer employer's contribution required under Section 742.33 of the Ohio Revised Code or providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, and other equipment used directly in the operation of a police department in West Chester Township, Butler County, Ohio (collectively, hereinafter the "Purposes");

WHEREAS, the Original Levies were first placed on the tax list and duplicate in the year 2001;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.192 of the Ohio Revised Code the Township proposes to replace the two existing Original Levies by combining them into one continuing replacement levy (the "Replacement Levy"), at a rate equal to the combined tax rate of the Original Levies;

WHEREAS, this Board has declared the necessity of levying the Replacement Levy, which represents an additional tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation; and,

WHEREAS, the County Auditor, upon request of this Board, has certified the total current tax valuation of this Township, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by said additional tax levy.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the West Chester Township Board of Trustees does hereby agree:

SECTION 1. This Board hereby determines and declares that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount of revenue to provide for the necessary requirements of West Chester Township, Butler County, Ohio and that it is therefore necessary to levy a replacement tax in excess of the 10-mill limitation providing funds for the Purposes at a rate not exceeding 7.0 mills for each one dollar of valuation, to be levied for a continuing period of time commencing with a levy on the duplicate of the current tax year, 2010, for first collection in calendar year 2011, such Replacement Levy to replace the Original Levies.

SECTION 2. That the question of the Replacement Tax levy not exceeding 7.0 mills for a continuing period of time commencing with the current tax year of 2010 and first due in calendar year 2011 to provide funds for the Purposes shall be submitted to the electors of the Township at an election to be held on November 2, 2010, as authorized by law.

SECTION 3. The Fiscal Officer of this Board is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections of Butler County, together with the Auditor's certification of Resolution 15-2010, pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. Pursuant to Section 5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
