## STATUTORY RESOLUTION NO. 37-2015

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS TO REVIEW ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION AND TO DETERMINE AND DECLARE A REASONABLE AND SAFE PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMIT ON LIBERTY WAY BETWEEN 0.3 MILES EAST OF CINCINNATI DAYTON ROAD AND COX ROAD IN BUTLER COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, a request has been made to this Board that the statutory vehicular speed limit established by Ohio Revised Code §4511.21 is greater (or less) than that considered reasonable and safe on Liberty Way between 0.3 Miles East of Cincinnati Dayton Road and Cox Road; and,

WHEREAS, this Board has caused to be made an engineering and traffic investigation upon the section of road described above; and,

WHEREAS, it is the belief of this Board that such investigation confirms the allegation that the statutory speed limit of 55 mph is unrealistic.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the West Chester Township Board of Trustees does hereby agree to:

SECTION 1. Request the Director of Highways, by virtue of the provisions of Ohio Revised Code §4511.21, to review the engineering and traffic investigation and to determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit on Liberty Way between 0.3 Miles East of Cincinnati Dayton Road and Cox Road in Butler County, Ohio.

Erect standard signs, properly posted, giving notice of the safe speed limit determined and declared reasonable by the Director of Highways, on the section of road described in Section 1 hereof.
