

**RESOLUTION NO. 30 - 2004**

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**RESOLUTION OBJECTING TO APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF LIQUOR PERMIT FOR RODRIGUEZ AND LEAL INCORPORATED DBA TEQUILA'S NIGHTCLUB AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING**

**WHEREAS**, Rodriguez and Leal Incorporated dba Tequila's Nightclub has applied for annual renewal of a D5 and D6 liquor permit as contained in Permit No. 7466371 to the Ohio Department of Liquor Control for the premises located at 10152 Princeton-Glendale Road, West Chester Township, Cincinnati, Ohio 45246; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of West Chester Township, the West Chester Township Police Department, and a neighboring group, object to the application for the above permit for the reasons set forth in Section 1 of this resolution hereof.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the West Chester Township Board of Trustees does hereby agree to:

**SECTION 1.** Object to the application of Rodriguez and Leal Incorporated dba Tequila's Nightclub, 10152 Princeton-Glendale Road, West Chester Township, Cincinnati, Ohio 45246, for renewal of a D5 and D6 liquor permit to be located at that address as contained in Application No. 7466371 to the Ohio Department of Liquor Control, on the grounds that the Board objects to the proposed annual renewal for the following reason(s):

A. The applicant has operated the liquor permit business in a manner that demonstrates a disregard for the laws, regulations and local ordinances and resolutions of this state.

B. The permit premise is so located with respect to the neighborhood that continued operation of the business will cause substantial interference with the public decency, sobriety, peace and good order of the neighborhood.

**SECTION 2.** Request a hearing on the above application be held in Hamilton, Butler County, Ohio, the county seat in the county in which the business is operated.

**SECTION 3.** Designate the Law Director or any of his assistants to represent the Board at any hearings pertaining to this application.

**SECTION 4.** Authorize the West Chester Township Clerk / Treasurer to forward two certified copies of this resolution, along with the written objections by the Board of Trustees, by registered or certified mail to the Director, Ohio Department of Liquor Control.

**SECTION 5.** Adopt this resolution as an emergency measure because the objection must be filed with the State of Ohio by May 3, 2004 and for the health and welfare of the community.

This resolution shall be adopted as an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare of the community and shall become effective at the earliest date permitted by law.
