RESOLUTION NO. 49-2004

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE WEST CHESTER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES ("WEST CHESTER") TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THROUGH AND ON BEHALF OF THE BUTLER COUNTY ENGINEER ("ENGINEER") FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A CULVERT ON DUFF DRIVE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapters 5535 and 5571, Trustees are responsible for the maintenance of Duff Drive, a township road within the boundaries of WestChester Township, Butler County, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 5589.06 prohibits the wrongful diversion of water from adjacent lands to a township road; and,

WHEREAS, Owners are the fee simple owners of the subject parcel(s) of real property, referenced in Exhibit A and Exhibit B; and,

WHEREAS, the Butler County Engineer, acting on behalf of the Trustees, has determined that the drainage pipes located on the Owners' parcels, as described respectively in either Exhibit A or Exhibit B, is inadequate for handling storm water runoff and that as a result the runoff water from Owners' property flows back up the roadside ditch and out onto Duff Drive causing a wrongful diversion of water upon the roadway as prohibited by Ohio Revised Code 5589.06 the Butler County Engineer, acting on behalf of the Township, has provided written notice to Owners to remove and replace said undersized pipe with adequately sized pipes and to install trench drains in order to stop said drainage overflow onto the roadway; and,

WHEREAS, the Butler County Engineer, acting on behalf of the Township, has provided written notice to Owners to remove and replace said undersized pipe with adequately sized pipes and to install trench drains in order to stop said drainage overflow onto the roadway; and,

WHEREAS, the Owners have failed to remove and replace the undersized pipe and install trench drains as instructed by the Township through the Butler County Engineer; and,

WHEREAS, the Butler County Engineer, acting on behalf of the Township, has agreed to perform the necessary work and Owners have agreed that it is necessary to perform said work and that the cost estimates provided by the Butler County Engineer for the work are reasonable; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties have agreed that all costs associated with said work performed by the Butler County Engineer for the project will ultimately be borne by Owners.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the West Chester Township Board of Trustees does hereby agree to:

SECTION 1. Enter into an Agreement with the Butler County Commissioners as through and on behalf of the Butler County Engineer to remove and replace the undersized pipes

with 24" pipe and install catch basins and trench drains across the existing driveway approaches to Duff Drive. Such work is described in the preliminary plans and cost estimate prepared by the Butler County Engineer's Office and attached in a letter, dated April 6, 2004, to Owners from the Butler County Engineer's Office.

SECTION 2. Authorize the Township Administrator to execute the attached Agreements, Exhibit A and Exhibit B with the respective property owners, stating the conditions, terms, and responsibilities of each party.

PIPE REPLACEMENT AGREEMENT FOR AUDITOR'S PERMANENT PARCEL NUMBER M5820-044-000.008

This Agreement made this 10 day of 2004, by and between The Board of Township Trustees of West Chester Township, Butler County, Ohio ("Trustees") and Rieman and Arszman Dry Wall Company, by and through Richard Arszman and Rose Marie Rieman ("Owners"), regarding property owned in fee simple by Owners at 5177 Duff Drive, in West Chester Township, Butler County, Ohio, 45056.

- 1. Township, by and through the Butler County Engineer, shall remove and replace the undersized pipes with 24" pipe and install catch basins and trench drains across the existing driveway approach to Duff Drive. Such work is described in the preliminary plans and cost estimate prepared by the Butler County Engineer's Office and attached in a letter, dated April 6, 2004, to Owners from the Butler County Engineer's Office; see Attached Exhibit.
- 2. The expenses incurred with said project will, in the first instance, be paid out of funds allocated to the Butler County Engineer's Office, and the Owners shall provide reimbursement for the project expenses through an assessment against, and placed upon the tax duplicate for, Owners' said property, to wit: Auditor's Permanent Parcel Number M5820-044-000.008, and shall be payable, without interest, in 14 equal semi-annual installments, in the same manner as real estate taxes.

- 4. Trustees agree to restore those areas of Owners' driveway and adjacent property affected by the project to as close to their current condition as is reasonable practicable.
- 5. Owners shall be responsible for all future maintenance of the piped frontage and shall hold Township, the Butler County Engineer's Office and the Board of Commissioners of Butler County, Ohio harmless against any and all claims for personal injury or property damages resulting therefrom.

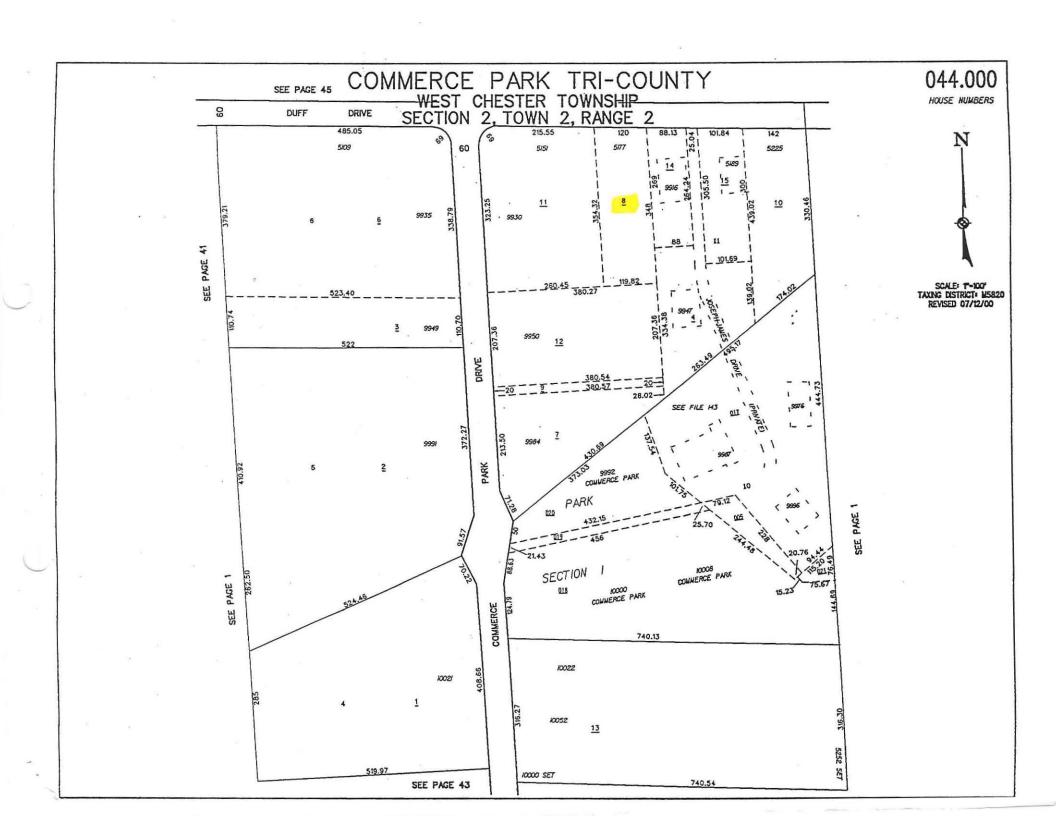
