

RESOLUTION NO. 12 - 2002

**RESOLUTION ENDORSING A PROPOSAL FOR REPLACEMENT
OF THE FAILING 42" WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN**

WHEREAS, Butler County's existing 42" Water Transmission Main, which was installed in the 1940's, has reached the end of its useful life and needs to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, this water main is located within the Township and provides water supply to the residents and businesses of the Township; and

WHEREAS, said water main was originally installed by the Federal Government in 1942; and

WHEREAS, growth in population and economic development in Butler County's water service area, including West Chester Township, requires the replacement of the 42" Water Transmission Main; and

WHEREAS, the Butler County Department of Environmental Services has documented said costs and expenses for the project and has prepared a Proposal for Replacement of the Failing 42" Water Transmission Main; and

WHEREAS, said Proposal shall serve as Butler County's application for funding request to the United States Government to replace the aforesaid failing 42" Water Transmission Main.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the West Chester Township Board of Trustees do hereby agree to:

Section 1. That said Proposal shall be submitted to the United States Government to apply for Federal funding to assist Butler County in the replacement of the failing 42" Water Transmission Main.


Section 2. That the Trustees supports the County's Total Funding Request of \$9,757,750 to replace the failing 42" Water Transmission Main.




