## RESOLUTION NO. 2000-34

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A "NO PARKING ZONE" ALONG BOTH SIDES OF FOUNTAINS BOULEVARD FROM KENNESAW DRIVE TO GREY FOX DRIVE

**WHEREAS**, West Chester Township Trustees are empowered by Ohio Revised Code §505.17 to regulate vehicle parking in the township; and

WHEREAS, the West Chester Township Police Department has determined that vehicle parking along a certain section of Fountains Boulevard in West Chester Township has become a hazard to vehicle, bike and pedestrian traffic; and

WHEREAS, West Chester Township Trustees agree with police officials that a "No Parking Zone" along a certain length of Fountains Boulevard is appropriate and necessary to preserve the health, safety and welfare of township residents; and

WHEREAS, notice of this proposed "No Parking Zone" has been posted in conspicuous places along the affected streets, and property owners have been notified accordingly; and

WHEREAS, notice has been duly published in a newspaper of general circulation in the township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Township of West Chester (hereinafter called the "Board"), County of Butler, Ohio,

- **Section 1.** That a "No Parking Zone" shall be created along both sides of Fountains Boulevard from Kennesaw Drive to Grey Fox Drive effective 30 days from the date this resolution is approved and signed
- **Section 2.** That notice of this proposed "No Parking Zone" shall be posted in five conspicuous public places in the township for thirty days prior to the effective date of enforcement, namely:
  - a. Township Police Department, 9113 Cincinnati Dayton Road
  - b. Middletown Branch Public Library, 7900 Cox Road
  - c. Voice Of America, 8070 Tylersville Road
  - d. West Chester Post Office, 8730 Cincinnati Dayton Road
  - e. Lakota Local District, Board of Education Office, 5030 Tylersville Road
- **Section 3.** That whoever violates this "No Parking Zone" regulation shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor;
- **Section 4.** That the Board or its designated agent may order into storage any vehicle parked in violation of this parking regulation.
