

RESOLUTION NO. 44-99

BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Trustees of Union Township, Butler County, Ohio that:

The Union Township Board of Trustees recommends to the Board of Butler County Commissioners that a personal property tax exemption be granted to **Enable Medical Corporation** for the purchase of machinery, equipment, furniture and fixtures and investment in new inventory.

Performance criteria related to the project for which the tax exemption is being recommended are the following:

- 1) Personal property tax exemption will be granted to **Enable Medical Corporation** on the \$400,000 (Four Hundred Thousand Dollars) in new machinery, equipment, furniture and fixtures and \$50,000 (Fifty Thousand Dollars) in taxable inventory associated with the project.
- 2) **Enable Medical Corporation** will create at least 35 new full-time employment positions over the first three years of the agreement and retain their current 27 employees at their facility in West Chester.

The Union Township Board of Trustees feels that approval of this negotiated exemption is in the best interest of the community. A voluntary agreement has been reached between **Enable Medical Corporation** and the Lakota School District to offset the impact of the proposed exemption may have on future tax collections.
