RESOLUTION NO. 95-30

BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Trustees of Union Township, Butler County, Ohio that:

- WHEREAS, in April 1992, the Union Township Board of Trustees created the 20/20 Committee to "Create a vision for Union Township for the Year 2012 and recommend implementation strategies to achieve that mission;" and
- WHEREAS, in September 1994, the Union Township Board of Trustees formed the Sidewalk and Bikepath Task Force as a result of the recommendation of the 2012 Vision Plan; and
- WHEREAS, the Sidewalk and Bikepath Task Force's charge was to develop an action and implementation plan for the prioritization of sidewalks and the location and construction of bicycle facilities throughout Union Township; and
- WHEREAS, one such implementation strategy was to secure means in financing the infrastructure improvements for the proposed bicycle facilities; and
- WHEREAS, on August 15, 1995, the Union Township Board of Trustees approved the Sidewalk and Bikepath Task Force to prepare the Transportation Enhancement Program application for the Cox Road Bicycle Lane Connector.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, on August 29, 1995, the Union Township Board of Trustees does hereby approve the Transportation Enhancement Program application for a 1.5 mile bicycle lane facility along Cox Road, connecting Hopewell Elementary and Junior High Schools, the Union Township Public Library, the West Chester Plaza retail center, McGinnis Park, and the Voice of America site to surrounding residential uses.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of the Union Township Board of Trustees to appropriate funds for the proposed project's engineering costs (\$58,875) and a local match of twenty (20) percent for total construction costs (\$117,750).
