

RESOLUTION NO. 95-32

BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Trustees of Union Township, Butler County, Ohio that:

This is to document the method of assessing lot owners who live in Union Township Lighting Districts:

- . The Township is invoiced by the utility provider (at this time it is C.G.&E.) separately for each Lighting District. These are documented separately in the Township accounting system.
- . Each year an assessment is sent to the Butler County Auditor with the cost the Township has paid out year-to-date plus a 10% administrative fee. This applies to each Lighting District.
- . This fee is divided equally against each benefited lot owner.
- . This equal amount is assessed on each lot owner's Real Estate tax bill.
- . These assessments are collected by Butler County Treasurer and returned to the Township twice a year as taxes are paid by the residents.
- . It should be noted that these collections received by the Township are deposited in and may be expended only from the Lighting Fund.
- . Estimated installation costs and estimated usage costs will be assessed on new Districts on the Tax Year they are approved by the Board of Trustees. This will also include the 10% administrative fee.
