

RESOLUTION NO. 92-47

Butler County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Union Township, that A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT THE QUESTION OF A TAX LEVY TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR PURSUANT TO SECTION 5705.19 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Township Trustees of Union Township, Butler County, Ohio that:

Section 1. This Board hereby determines and declares that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the 10-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount of revenue to provide for the necessary requirements of Union Township, Butler County, Ohio and that it is therefore necessary to levy an additional tax in excess of the 10-mill limitation to provide funds for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in Union Township, Butler County, Ohio, at a rate not exceeding 1.25 mills for each One Dollar of valuation for a continuing period of time, commencing with a levy on the duplicate of the current tax year.

Section 2. The question of such additional tax levy not exceeding 1.25 mills for a continuing period of time commencing with the current tax year of 1992 for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in Union Township, Butler County, Ohio, shall be submitted to the electors of the Township at the general election to be held on November 3, 1992, as authorized by law.

Section 3. The Clerk of this Board is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of the Butler County.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The foregoing resolution was submitted upon the motion by Mr. Cates and seconded by Alderson. Upon call of the roll, the vote was as follows: Mr. Cates: yes; Mr. Alderson: yes; Mrs. Shaffner: yes.
