

RESOLUTION NO. 91-44

Butler County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Union Township, that :

Whereas, Senate Bill #170 is pending before the Ohio State Legislature, and

Whereas certain provisions of the bill intended to equalize State Funding for Local School Districts will,

a. Recalculate State Funding for some school districts by redistributing State Aid from some and to others, pulling down adequately funded districts to subsidize others.

b. Result in Butler County, Ohio realizing a net loss of educational funding of over \$9 million dollars with 7 out of 9 Butler County Districts experiencing a net loss of State revenue.

c. Result in the Lakota School District experiencing the second largest decrease in State Funding (\$8.4 million in 1997). and,

Whereas, the Lakota School District has consistently distinguished itself as a "low spending district" which has earned the support of the citizenry through competency and sound fiscal management, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Union Township Trustees expresses its unqualified opposition to Senate Bill 170, and urges our local State Senators, and State Representatives to actively seek its failure in the legislature.
