

RESOLUTION No. 4-90

Butler County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Union Township,

that WHEREAS, The Decennial Census of Population and Housing is mandated by the U.S. Constitution to determine representation in the United States House of Representatives, and

WHEREAS, Census data are used to determine the allocation of billions of dollars to federal, state, county, township and municipal governments, and

WHEREAS, the 1990 Census will create more than 400,000 new temporary job opportunities that require persons of good work ethic and determination,

WHEREAS, Census data are used by community organization, businesses, planning agencies and religious for program planning, grants, fund raising and advocacy, and other endeavors for the betterment of the citizens of the Greater Cincinnati area and more particularly Union Township.

WHEREAS, NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Union Township, Butler County, Ohio, endorses the Bureau of the Census Goal of a complete and accurate enumeration in the 1990 Census, and be it further,

RESOLVED, that Union Township, Butler County will publicize its endorsement of the 1990 Census through its own publications and through external media, urging all of its citizens to cooperate; and be it further

RESOLVED, that Union Township, Butler County also encourages all of its corporate citizens to endorse the 1990 Census and encourage their employees to cooperate.
