Be it resolved by the Township Trustees of Union Township that

WHEREAS, the Hamilton-Mason and LeSourdesville-West Chester Road intersection is a currently a two-way stop intersection; and

WHEREAS, the increasing residential development near the intersection has resulted in higher volumes of traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Butler County Engineer has conducted a study of the intersection and recommended the installation of a four-way stop with a flashing beacon for the safety of motorists; and

WHEREAS, Union Township and Liberty Township have mutually agreed to the equitable division of improvement costs to the intersection; and

WHEREAS, these improvements are a benefit to Union Township.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that Union Township agrees to accept and pay the share of the aforementioned intersection improvement as specified in the attached agreement with Liberty Township.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 5th day of January, 1988 by and between Union Township, Butler County, Ohio, acting by and through its duly authorized Trustees as the First Part and Liberty Township, Butler County, Ohio, acting by and through its duly authorized Trustees as the Second Part.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Hamilton-Mason and LeSourdesville-West Chester Road intersection is a currently a two-way stop intersection; and

WHEREAS, the increasing residential development near the intersection has resulted in higher volumes of traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Butler County Engineer has conducted a study of the intersection and recommended the installation of a four-way stop with a flashing beacon for the safety of motorists; and

WHEREAS, this intersection is partly within Union Township and partly within Liberty Township.

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed between the parties to said Agreement as follows:

1. Union Township will:

- (a) Prepare necessary estimates for the work, subject to the approval of Liberty Township.
- (b) Contract for the installation of the beacon signal
- (c) Assume all normal maintenance costs.
- (d) Pay fifty percent (50%) of the installation costs (estimated at \$2,171.00)

2. Liberty Township will:

- (a) Pay fifty percent (50%) of the installation costs (estimated at \$2,171.00)
