Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Union Township,

that:

to be consistent with the request of the Butler County Engineer as well as the Butler County Commissioners that the Union Township Board of Trustees approve the responsibilities and accept the responsibilities as outlined in the Butler County Commissioner's resolution for the assumption and responsibility of maintenance and policing of this facility to be known as the BIKEWAY starting from Keehner Park Driveway to Brookridge Drive. Path parallel to Cox Road (within the right of way) from Charter Oak Drive to Tylersville Road including a structure over a branch of Gregory Creek. Establish a bike route (signing only) from Keehner Park to the proposed bike path along Cox Road. The route will begin at Keehner Park over Fruitwood Avenue to Elkwood Drive; thence to Grinn Drive to Bonnie Drive; over Bonnie Drive to Ventle Drive; thence to Charter Oak Drive to the beginning of the bike path along Cox Road. The bike route will be 6300 feet in length.

WHEREAS, the public interest demands the improvement hereinafter described.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Butler County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the County, that:

SECTION I. - The public interest demands the ~~improvement of the~~ _____

Construction of a bikeway

_____, situated in the County of Butler, State of Ohio, and described as follows:

Construct an 8' wide bike path from Keehner Park Driveway to Brookridge Drive. Construct an 8' wide bike path parallel to Cox Road (within the right of way) from Charter Oak Drive to Tylersville Road including a structure over a branch of Gregory Creek. Establish a bike route (signing only) from Keehner Park to the proposed bike path along Cox Road. The route will begin at Keehner Park over Fruitwood Avenue to Elkwood Drive; thence to Grinn Drive to Bonnie Drive; over Bonnie Drive to Ventle Drive; thence to Charter Oak Drive to the beginning of the bike path along Cox Road. The bike route will be 6300 feet in length.

SECTION II - The County does hereby propose to assume and contribute the entire cost and expense of the improvement less the amount of Federal-Aid funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation, and further, the County agrees to bear one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of the following items:

- (1) Preliminary Engineering
- (2) ~~Construction~~ Rights-of-way
- (3) ~~Construction~~ All costs for added construction items generating extra work contracts under Ohio Laws, unless performance is approved by the State of Ohio and the Federal Highway Administration before work is authorized.
- (4) The County will also assume and bear responsibility for maintaining and policing the facility.

SECTION III. - The County agrees to arrange for the relocation, rearrangement or alteration of all utilities of any nature whatsoever whether privately, publicly or cooperatively owned, which will be affected by or interfere with said improvement and said rearrangements will be done at such time as requested by the Director of Transportation. The cost of the relocation, rearrangement and alteration of such utilities affected and payment therefor shall be in accordance with Ohio Department of Transportation Directive 28-A.

SECTION IV. - The Board of County Commissioners agrees that all rights of way required for the improvement will be acquired in accordance with all applicable State and Federal regulations in force and effect.


Dear Mr. Osner:
