

RESOLUTION No. 2-80

Butler County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Union Township,

that

WHEREAS Union Township residents adopted the Butler County Zoning Resolution in November, 1956, and have operated continuously since that time under that resolution and its revisions, which have been administered by Butler County, and

WHEREAS Union Township has experienced and is continuing to encounter unprecedented growth over all the townships in Butler County to the extent that the bulk of the building and zoning activity in the County occurs in Union Township, and

WHEREAS even with the direct citizen representation of Union Township on every board or commission in the County that is involved with zoning or planning, the ultimate control nevertheless rests outside Union Township, and

WHEREAS it appears that, with the continually changing environment of Union Township, the best interests of the residents in matters of zoning would be served better through local control,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Union Township declares its intention to proceed with establishing township zoning under Sections 519.02 through 519.25, inclusive, of the Ohio Revised Code.
